PR Report

- Discussed the importance of presentations. So far, there have been 9 PR presentations in 2018 in the Georgia Region
- There will be an H&I and PR Learning Day in Jessup, GA on May 12. Primarily targeted towards areas in South Georgia.
- The SEZF is funding a booth at the RX Drug Abuse and Heroin Summit April 2-5. The SEZF paid \$3600 to cover both the space and registrations for people to occupy the booth. Representatives from the Georgia Region and the Alabama-Northwest Florida Region have been selected to attend.
- We have a PR booth. It's nice. The graphics were \$243. Any area that wants to use it can.
- Duane, formerly the Vice Chair, has been nominated for Chair.
- The PR Committee needs a Secretary.
- We now have the ability to print Metro Atlanta Meeting Schedules. I have copies to hand out to GSRs. If we chose to, we could hand these out instead of just area meeting schedules. There would be a financial impact.
- We now have the option to move our phone line to the regional level. We still keep control of an area-level phone line. We get a login, and can add the helpline volunteer phone numbers. It's pretty easy to use. There's also an automated meeting search option powered by "yap". This would get rid of our Answerphone bill, and save more than \$1200 per year.
 - o User calls our number. Press 1 to find a meeting, Press 2 to talk to someone.
User presses 1, and can do a meeting search using their phone. Meeting results get read to them and texted to them.
User presses 2, it calls the Marietta Area cell phone on file in order until someone answers.

H&I Report

- The general consensus is that H&I at the regional level is really struggling. Area H&I Chairs are not showing up. None of the positions are being filled. It's basically been a one-man show (the current and outgoing H&I Chair), plus a small number of RCMs that attend the meeting. There is a call for people to get involved in regional H&I.

Topics

All of these topics go “back to groups”

2018-001 – To approve the use of an Electronic Funds Transfer to pay bills

- This came about because some of the companies we do business with no longer accept checks. It's 2018, y'all.
- Changes two spots in policy to allow bills to be paid by check or by EFT.
- Still requires prior approval of two admin committee members. Now they must initial the invoice before the treasurer is authorized to send the payment.

2018-002 – Change policy to reimburse mileage based at 80% of the federal standard, rather than modifying the amount each year.

- This actually doesn't change anything. For years, the region has reimbursed mileage at 80% of the price outlined in the federal guidelines. Each year, there has been a change to policy to adjust the reimbursement rate to 80% of the new federal rate. This change just removes the need to adjust policy each year by stating clearly that we reimburse at 80% of the federal rate.
- The change is from “43 cents reimbursement” to “80% of the federal guidelines”.

2018-003 – To recognize new area – consensus reached

- This was just to recognize them. At the next RSC we decide whether or not to give them voting privileges.
- The area was formed because they felt their needs were not being met by the Midtown or North Atlanta service committees.
- They currently have three groups, and expect more groups to follow.
- We need to send our RCM back to the next RSC with a conscience on this.
