Jonathan M: I'm Jonathan and I'm an addict. The Ridgeview Friday night H&I meeting was canceled a couple, a month or two ago, and we've had some people go and talk to the administration at Ridgeview and they have offered to let us make it an open meeting. Just a normal NA meeting, they're not going to do an H&I meeting, but the residents are still able to come to that open meeting so we have started a new homegroup, we've met for two weeks, this past Friday and the Friday before that, we had a group conscience and they voted me as GSR so I'm just bringing it to the area's attention.

Chuck E: Does it have a name yet?

Jonathan M: No.

Chuck E: When the meeting first started years ago, the name was the Freedom Group, so maybe you can suggest that to keep the tradition alive.

Jonathan M: Yeah, we talked about that and there were some of us that didn't,

because I thought that meeting got closed under weird circumstances.

Chuck E: Yeah, I just thought it might be a nice... thing.

Katey G: Did you want to say anything to the floor? Anything else about the new

meeting?

Rodney W: So is that meeting, because like in the past, I think the reason it got closed was because there was no cussing in that meeting and I think that's the reason it got shut down. Exactly, because there was cussing and what have you in the meeting. I know that it was a thing with Ridgeview back then, and I don't care, I just want it to be known, you know put out there, that like, it may be a thing.

Steffen T: I was going to say the same thing. What I do know is that as of now the facility doesn't have a rule against residents cussing, just from my experience at Ridgeview, and from what I know, there was a particular individual who would tell a repetitive story that involved cussing, that was the big issue, not so much the content of what he was saying but the actual cussing itself. This is my understanding, so we don't have a policy in place for no cussing, but to my knowledge, neither does the facility at this point.

Rodney W: Okay, well, I was just curious because of that individual and what happened back then, and have ya'll taken steps to counteract that to maybe protect the meeting in the future, I don't know.

Jonathan M: Yeah, we've talked about what we would do if we have a person who becomes disruptive to the meeting, like we've read what NA World Service has about violent/disruptive behavior in meetings and we've talked about not letting them threaten the existence of our meeting or the atmosphere of recovery, so.

Katey G: Anything else on this topic?

Chris B: Can we get them lit?

Katey G: Yeah, they can ask for that.

Jonathan M: Yeah, we have some literature.

Chris B: Yeah, you guys get \$50 [of literature] automatically.

Julie N: We'll probably do that next area.

Melissa P: How's your attendance been from outside [the facility], like do you guys need support?

Jonathan M: We would like support, this is just like my personal thing, but the first day we met we had like 20 people and 5 of them were residents and I like that, I like that there were 15 people with recovery from the outside bringing the message to the 5 people on the inside, and then this past week we had like 15 people with a similar ratio [of outside-inside the facility], so yes, we would like anyone who has time or willingness to come to come and support us.
