The Vice-Chair is not expected to replace a subcommittee chair."

ASC MOTION 3-2: To donate little-used excess literature in the area literature inventory to homegroups and subcommittees in order to clear inventory and make that literature available to those who might use it. Each homegroup will be given the following package of literature at a cost of \$3.24 per group: 1 copy each of Group Booklet, Disruptive and Violent Behavior, NA Groups and Medication, Principles/Leadership in NA Service, and Social Media & Guiding Principles and 2 copies of Group Business Meetings and Group Trusted Servants. H&I will be donated 45 copies of Behind the Walls at a cost of \$45, 100 copies of IP #17 For Those in Treatment at a cost of \$25, and 6 copies of H&I Basics at a cost of \$3.90. PR will be donated 77 copies of Information About NA at a cost of \$24.62 and 11 copies of PR Basics at a cost of \$7.15. 50 outdated copies of The Membership Survey valued at \$16 (from 2010 & 2016) will be donated to PR or other parts of the ASC and 2 outdated copies of A Guide to World Services valued at \$9.10 will also be donated to the ASC.

Intent: At some point in the distant past, too many service pamphlets and other items

were ordered. They are not being purchased and I would not expect them to decrease significantly in the next decade. Donating this literature to other parts of our service structure will free up inventory space to be able to stock more frequently used titles and will get overstocked items in the hands of groups and subcommittees that could use them. The total financial impact will be \$130.77 donated to the ASC and subcommittees, and \$3.24 for homegroups (\$74.52).

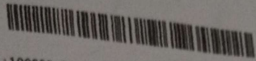

Policy subcommittee met once in March. We have continued working through the Financial Guidelines article, and have prepared recommended policy for banking. We are currently drafting the specific language, but our initial thoughts include:

- Remove two-signer requirements because banks won't honor it
- Update Treasurer job description to add the job of delivering detailed accounting report at monthly ASC meeting
- Add policy to have Lit Chair hold the checks
- Add policy to have Chair or Vice-Chair sign and review the checks at ASC meeting that the Treasurer has prepared
- Remove Secretary as signer on the bank account
- Add policy that signer and check-holder cannot co-habitate

We also discussed updating cleantime requirements for the trusted servant positions that handle the bank accounts, and we will present these recommendations alongside the proposed new policy when it's ready.

We also spent time discussing the way the Area votes for motions that come from Region and World. Because they operate on a Consensus-based system and we operate on Robert's Rules, sometimes the way we vote on issues doesn't directly translate to how the area conscious gets expressed Region. The committee intends to write policy that will instruct RCM's on how to interpret our Area votes and express them in the language of CBDM.

Hey family - When I took over literature, we had quite a backlog of several service pamphlets and lesser-used IPs. My guess is that someone in the past (and we really have no way of knowing how far back that was) ordered in bulk without necessarily thinking about how much certain pieces of literature are in demand. The downside to keeping all this stock is that it eats up our lit reserve money, meaning that we order and stock less of the literature most groups use. Also, this literature might be useful for groups or subcommittees, but may not be at the top of their list of items to order.

To help with this problem, I'm making a motion to donate some of this literature to home groups, H&I, & PR. I think the groups and subcommittees will find this literature helpful, and it will help clear out some of that stock (although for some titles we'll probably continue to have them for years). I've included a list of some of the pieces of literature to which I'm referring and how many copies we currently have in stock.: *Group Booklet* (50), *Group Business Meeting* (97), *Group Trusted Servants* (76), *Disruptive and Violent Behavior* (93), *NA Groups and Medication* (35), *Principles/Leadership in NA* (44), *Social Media & Guiding Principles* (38), *Behind the Walls* (49), *IP#17 For Those in Treatment* (142), *Information About NA* (97), *H&I Basics* (8), *PR Basics* (13)
